RESCINDED

TOWN OF SMOKY LAKE

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SMOKY LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE ASSESSOR AS A DESIGNATED OFFICER FOR THE TOWN OF SMOKY LAKE

WHEREAS, The Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto requires that an Assessor be appointed as a Designated Officer:

THEREFORE, THE Council of the Town of Smoky Lake, duly assembled, enacts as follows:


1. That Mike Krim of Capital Region Assessment Services Commission is hereby appointed as a Designated Officer (Assessor) for the Town of Smoky Lake effective July 1, 2007.
2. That Mr. Mike Krim, as Designated Officer, for the Town of Smoky Lake shall carry out the duties of the Assessor as outlined by, and not limited to, Parts 9, 10, 11 and 12, inclusive, of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, and amendments thereto, as well as all services as outlined in the Assessment Services Agreement and any other taxation or assessment matters as required by the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Smoky Lake.
3. Capital Region Assessment Services Commission and all its employees are deemed to be an independent contractor none of whom shall be considered to be employees of the Town of Smoky Lake.
4. That any and all previous Bylaws to appoint an assessor as a Designated Officer of the Town of Smoky Lake are hereby rescinded.
5. This By-Law No. 004-08 shall come into effective upon the date of passing of the third and final reading and shall remain in effect until such time as it is repealed or rescinded by a consequent Bylaw.


FIRST READING of By-Law No. 004-08 granted this 20th day of February, 2008.
