WORKS.**


UNDER authority of and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Town of Smoky Lake, duly assembled, enacts as follows:


WHEREAS the Town of Smoky Lake considers it necessary to provide for the safety of Town residents:

THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Smoky Lake, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall fire or set off any fire crackers or fire works within Town limits without first obtaining a permit from the Smoky Lake Fire Department.
2. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provisions of this bylaw may be liable to penalties.
3. That By-law 196 and subsequent amendments be repealed upon the final passing of this Bylaw.


