

BYLAW NO. 009-07
of the
TOWN OF SMOKY LAKE
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

To amend part of the Fire Services Bylaw #737-98

A Bylaw of the Town of Smoky Lake, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to provisions of the Municipal Government Act Chapter M-26.1, 1994 and amendments hereto;

Whereas, under the provisions of the Act, and in accordance with the directives of Bylaw #737-98, it is the desire of the Municipal Council of the Town of Smoky Lake to provide fire service and for the provision of the efficient operation of fire prevention services to the Town of Smoky Lake.

Whereas, it is the desire of the Council of the Town of Smoky Lake to make changes to certain clauses of the Fire Services Bylaw in order to address current issues and concerns;

And Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Town of Smoky Lake, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Section 4.5, Clause a.i, referring to age of membership be changed to read:
a.i be between the age of sixteen (16) years and sixty-five (65) years inclusive; and
2. That Section 4.5 Clause a.ii referring to possession of a minimum Class Five (5) driver's license be deleted.

Now Therefore it is understood that the passing of this Bylaw does not serve to rescind Bylaw 737-98, but shall serve as an amendment with only the above noted changes.


3. that this Bylaw shall come into effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
