LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTION ACT (SECTIONS 12, 35, 46)

FOR THE

TOWN OF SMOKY LAKE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

- A. Notice is hereby given that an Election will be held for the filling of the following offices:

- B. That an election will be held for the election of a Senate nominee for the purpose of the Alberta Senate Election Act.
- C. That a vote of the selectors will be held on the following referendum questions under the Referendum Act.
- Should section 36(2) of the Constitution Act, 1982-Parliament, and the government of Canada's commitment to the principle of making equalization payments be removed from the constitution?
 - Do you want Alberta to adopt year-round Daylight-Saving Time, which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?

Voting will take place on the 18th of October 2021 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Voting stations will be located at:

Smoky Lake Seniors Citizens Centre @ 124 White Earth Street, Smoky Lake, AB.

Institutional voting stations will be located at:

Smoky Lake Foundation (Bar V Nook Manor) 4524-52 Ave.

George McDougal Hospital (Auxiliary Long-term Care) 4212-55 Ave.

In order to vote, you must produce identification for inspection. The identification must be one or more of:

- Photo identification issued by a Canadian government agency, whether federal, provincial, or local, or an agency of that government that contains a photograph of the elector and their name and current address.
- Bank/credit card statement of personal cheque
- Government cheque or cheque stub
- Income/property tax assessment notice
- Insurance policy or coverage card
- Letter from a public curator, public guardian, or public trustee.
- Pension plan statement of benefits, contributions, or participation
- Residential lease or mortgage statement
- Statement of government benefits (e.g., employment insurance, old-age security, social assistance, disability support or child tax benefit)
- Utility bill
- Vehicle ownership, registration, or insurance certificate
- A letter or form (attestation) confirming that the person lives at the stated address will also be accepted as valid proof.

As required by Section 53 of the Local Authorities Election Act or local bylaw.
