### REFERENDUM BALLOT INFORMATION

That a vote of the electors will be held on the following referendum question(s) under the Referendum Act. Both referendum questions allow for a 'yes' vote or a 'no' vote and are binding on the provincial government, based on the majority of votes cast.

1. Should section 36(2) of the Constitution Act, 1982 – Parliament and the government of Canada's commitment to the principle of making equalization payments – be removed from the constitution?
2. Do you want Alberta to adopt a year-round Daylight Saving Time, which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?

### VOTER IDENTIFICATION (ID) REQUIREMENTS

Proof of identity and current residence is required to be able to vote in municipal elections. The easiest option for voters to provide is to show 1 piece of government issued ID (including your photograph, full legal name, and your current street address within the Town of Smoky Lake).

- Alberta Driver's License or
- Alberta ID card.

If a voter's identification shows a post office box number as the address instead of a residential or legal address, it can be accepted as verification of current address if it is in reasonable distance to the voting jurisdiction. The address does not have to be in the voting division or ward.

Other ways to prove identity:

- 2 documents with the voter's name and address on them will be accepted as valid proof, see the full list at <https://www.elections.ab.ca/wp-content/uploads/Authorized-Identification-Poster.pdf>
- If you are unable to provide any identification, or cannot confirm your current physical address, you can be vouched for by another registered elector in your polling subdivision or use the attestation process at [www.elections.ab.ca/voters/id-required-to-vote/](http://www.elections.ab.ca/voters/id-required-to-vote/).
