BYLAW NO. 001-06

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SMOKY LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF SMOKY LAKE TO INCUR INDEBTEDNESS BY THE ISSUANCE OF DEBENTURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$395,435.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF WATERMAIN REPLACEMENTS AND A NEW WATERMAIN. TO RESCIND BYLAW 0802-05.

WHEREAS:

The Council of the Municipality has decided to issue a by-law pursuant to Section 258 of the *Municipal Government Act* to authorize the financing, undertaking and completion of the watermain replacement on White Earth Street, Willow Creek Street, McDougal Drive, and New watermain east of CNR tracks.

Plans and specifications have been prepared and the total cost of the project is estimated to be \$779,465.00 and the Municipality estimates the following grants and contributions will be applied to the project:

In order to complete the project it will be necessary for the Municipality to borrow the sum of \$395,435.00, for a period not to exceed 10 years, from the Alberta Capital Finance Authority or another authorized financial institution, by the issuance of debentures and on the terms and conditions referred to in this bylaw.

The estimated lifetime of the project financed under this by-law is equal to, or in excess of 10 years.

The principal amount of the outstanding debt of the Municipality at December 31, 2004 is \$229,079.05 and no part of the principal or interest is in arrears.

All required approvals for the project have been obtained and the project is in compliance with all *Acts* and *Regulations* of the Province of Alberta.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That for the purpose of watermain replacement and new watermain the sum of Three Hundred Ninety Five Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Five DOLLARS (\$395,435.00) be borrowed from the Alberta Capital Finance Authority or another authorized financial institution by way of debenture on the credit and security of the Municipality at large, of which amount the full sum of \$395,435.00 is to be paid by the Municipality at large.
- 2. The proper officers of the Municipality are hereby authorized to issue debenture(s) on behalf of the Municipality for the amount and purpose as authorized by this by-law, namely watermain replacement on White Earth Street, Willow Creek Street, McDougal Drive, as well as new watermain east of CNR Tracks.
- 3. The Municipality shall repay the indebtedness according to the repayment structure in effect, namely semi-annual or annual equal payments of combined principal and interest instalments not to exceed ten (10) years calculated at a rate not exceeding the interest rate fixed by the Alberta Capital Finance Authority or another authorized financial institution on the date of the borrowing, and not to exceed (10) percent.
- 4. The Municipality shall levy and raise in each year municipal taxes sufficient to pay the indebtedness.
- 5. The indebtedness shall be contracted on the credit and security of the Municipality.
- 6. The net amount borrowed under the by-law shall be applied only to the project specified by this by-law.
- 7. This by-law comes into force on the date it is passed.
- 8. This by-law rescinds by-law 802-05.




