BYLAW NO 013-13

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SMOKY LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ENTER INTO A FRANCHISE AGREEMENT WITH ATCO ELECTRIC LTD.

A Bylaw of the Town of Smoky Lake to enter into an agreement granting ATCO ELECTRIC LTD., the right to provide electric distribution service within the Town of Smoky Lake.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions the Municipal Government Act R.S.A., 2000 c. M-26, as amended, The Town of Smoky Lake desires to grant ATCO ELECTRIC LTD. to obtain, an exclusive franchise to provide electric distribution service within the Town of Smoky Lake for a period of 10 years subject to the right of renewal as set forth in the said agreement and in the said Act;

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Smoky Lake and ATCO ELECTRIC LTD., agreed to enter into an Electric Distribution System Franchise Agreement in the form annexed hereto;

WHEREAS it is deemed that the Agreement would be to the general benefit of the consumers within the Town of Smoky Lake.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Smoky Lake enacts as follows:

- 1) THAT the Electric Distribution System Franchise Agreement, a copy of which is annexed hereto as Schedule "A", be and the same is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved, and the Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer are hereby authorized to enter into the Electric Distribution System Franchise Agreement for and on behalf of the Town of Smoky Lake, and the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to affix thereto the corporate seal of the Town of Smoky Lake.
- 2) **THAT** the Electric Distribution System Franchise Agreement annexed hereto as Schedule "A" is hereby incorporated in, and made part of, this Bylaw.
- 3) THAT the Council consents to the exercise by ATCO ELECTRIC LTD. within the Town of Smoky Lake of any of the powers given to ATCO ELECTRIC LTD. by the <u>Water</u>, <u>Gas</u> and Electric Companies Act. R.S.A. 2000 c. W-4, as amended.

- 4) THAT this Bylaw shall come into force upon the Electric Distribution System Franchise Agreement being approved by the Alberta Utilities Commission and upon being given third reading and finally passed.
- 5) THAT Bylaw No 789-03 is herby rescinded.
