



BYLAW NO. 024 - 2020
TOWN OF SMOKY LAKE
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SMOKY LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA BEING A BYLAW to authorize the Town to incur indebtedness to the Government of Alberta (formerly Alberta Capital Finance Authority) for the purpose of installing solar panels for Municipal Buildings.

This bylaw authorizes the Council of the Town of Smoky Lake to incur indebtedness by the issuance of debenture(s) in

the amount of \$306,000.00 for the purpose of

Solar Power for Municipal Buildings

WHEREAS:

The Council of the Municipality has decided to issue a bylaw pursuant to Section 258 of the *Municipal Government Act* to authorize the financing, undertaking and completion of the

Solar Power for Municipal Buildings

Plans and specifications have been prepared and the total cost of the project is estimated to be \$306,000.00 and the Municipality estimates the following grants and contributions will be applied to the project:

Capital Reserves

Provincial Grants

Debentures

Total Costs

In order to complete the project, it will be necessary for the Municipality to borrow the sum of \$306,000.00, for a period not to exceed Twenty (20) years, from the Province of Alberta or another

authorized financial institution, by the issuance of debentures and on the terms and conditions referred to in this bylaw.

The estimated lifetime of the project financed under this bylaw is equal to, or in excess of Twenty (20) years.

The principal amount of the outstanding debt of the Municipality at December 31, 2019 is \$4,820,288.00 and no part of the principal or interest is in arrears.

All required approvals for the project have been obtained and the project is in compliance with all Acts and Regulations of the Province of Alberta.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That for the purpose of constructing the

Solar Power for Municipal Buildings

the sum of Three Hundred and Six Thousand DOLLARS

(\$306,000.00) be borrowed from the Province of Alberta or another authorized financial institution by way of debenture on the credit and security of the Municipality at large, of which amount the full sum of \$306,000.00 is to be paid by the Municipality at large.

2. The proper officers of the Municipality are hereby authorized to issue debenture(s) on behalf of the Municipality for the amount and purpose as authorized by this bylaw, namely the

Solar Power for Municipal Buildings

3. The Municipality shall repay the indebtedness according to the repayment structure in effect, namely semi-annual or annual equal payments of combined principal and interest instalments not to exceed Twenty (20)

years calculated at a rate not exceeding the interest rate fixed by the Province of Alberta, or another authorized financial institution, on the date of the borrowing, and not to exceed Three (3) percent.


4. The Municipality shall levy and raise in each year municipal taxes sufficient to pay the indebtedness.

5. The indebtedness shall be contracted on the credit and security of the Municipality.

6. The net amount borrowed under the bylaw shall be applied only to the project specified by this bylaw.

7. This bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.




